praying mantis

NAME: Hierodula membranacea

FROM: Asia

EATS: Insects and small vertebrates

SIZE: Up to 9cm in length

AGE: Up to 25 years

SEXING: Males are slimmer and can fly well

HOUSING: Best kept alone

The closest relatives of the mantises are the cockroaches.

The movement of a mantis head is also remarkably flexible, permitting nearly 300 degrees of movement in some species, allowing for a great range of vision.

Cannibalism is common among mantises when mating in captivity, the female biting off the male's head.

Mantises produce egg cases called 'ootheca'.

These are laid in a foaming mass but soon dry out and can contain up to 400 eggs.
